We recommend you take samples from your cabinetry, tile, flooring, paint color and any other items you may be trying to coordinate your choice of countertop with.



Allow enough time to look at all of the beautiful stones in a leisurely manner, making your experience very pleasant. Not allowing yourself enough time will make you feel overwhelmed due to the large variety.



If you find a color you like that is not on your Wallstone Selection List, simply call our home office for a quote on the color you are interested in.



When you decide on a color, ask the person helping you to “tag” TWO (2) slabs from the same lot by placing your name on it. We will release it if it’s not needed. This process is also referred to as placing your stone “On Hold”.



We recommend you call Wallstone with your choice of slab color to verify that your slab selection is complete.



After slabs have been chosen and tagged, Wallstone will call you to set up an appointment to do the final template on your countertop and contract signing for your project.
